Code of Conduct - Players

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.

As a player, you have a major part to play in this.

That is why the Club supports the F.A. Respect Code of Conduct and asks that every player adheres to the following guidelines.

When playing or being involved in football, I will:

- Always play to the best of my ability
- Play fairly - I won't cheat, complain or waste time
- Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee and my coach/manager
- Play by the rules, as directed by the referee
- Shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game
- Listen and respond to what my coach/ team manager tells me
- Talk to someone I trust or the Club Welfare Officer if I'm unhappy about anything at my club.

Failure to follow the code means that the following action(s) may be taken by my Club or the FA

I may:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager
- Receive a formal warning from the coach or the club committee
- Be dropped or substituted
- Be suspended from training
- Be required to leave the club.

In addition:

- My club, County FA or The FA may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct
- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and suspension against my club.
